

## Local School Council

Dear Lyon/Pleasant Ridge Parents,

The Lyon/Pleasant Ridge PTA has been charged with the responsibility of conducting an election to select two parents who will serve on the Lyon/Pleasant Ridge Local School Council. One parent will serve as the representative for Lyon School for a two-year term. The other parent will represent Pleasant Ridge School, also for a two-year term. If you want to represent Lyon School, you must have a child attending Lyon during the September 2011 and September 2012 school years. The same requirements are needed for the Pleasant Ridge representative.

The Local School Council is made up of 10 voting members: Four parents (two representing each of the schools), four teachers (two representing each of the schools), and the two principals. The primary purpose of the Local School Council is to develop goals and objectives on an annual basis. Meetings take place once per month during the school year.

Any parent who is interested in holding a position for the Local School Council must meet the following requirements:

1. Cannot be employed full-time by District 34 or be a member of the District 34 School Board.
2. Cannot concurrently serve on the Lyon/Pleasant Ridge PTA board.
3. Must have a child at the school they are representing for the entire term.

The application must be filled out and returned to the school's office or e-mailed to [president@lyonprpta.org](mailto:president@lyonprpta.org) no later than **Friday, October 7th**.
