Masterpiece of the Month Norman Rockwell Thanksgiving and Freedom From Want

60 minute Lesson Plan

Objective: As a result of this lesson, students will learn *how* Norman Rockwell painted and *why* he is an important painter/ illustrator in American Art. In addition, they will design and draw (in full color) their own mock cover of the *Saturday Evening Post*.

Recommended Materials:

- Rockwell's two prints,: Thanksgiving and Freedom from Want
- student photographs from home that depict family and/or celebrations
- Video: Norman Rockwell: An America Portrait video available at the Glenview Public Library
- Books: Norman Rockwell's Americana (ABC) by G. Mendoza and Norman Rockwell: The Life of An Artist by J. Roy – both available at Glenview Public Library
- The Saturday Evening Post cover template

- I Introduce Norman Rockwell (5 minutes)
- II. Show first 2 minutes of video to introduce students to Norman Rockwell
- III. Read page 4 in *Life of An Artist* book. (1 minute)
- IV.Read *ABC* book. (10 minutes)
- IV. Introduce Freedom From Want. (10 minutes)
 - a. Have children observe the art using principles in art
 - Is this painting realistic?
 - What materials did Norman Rockwell use to create this picture?
 - What kind of colors do you see?
 - How does this picture make you feel?

- What shapes are used throughout this piece?
- b. ask leading questions to inspire dialogue and deeper observation:
 - What's going on in this picture?
 - What do you see that makes you say that?
 - What more can you find?
 - Why do you suppose Rockwell left one seat empty at the dinning table?
- c. Introduce Thanksgiving print. (10 minutes)
 - Ask: What's going on in this picture?
 - What words can you use to describe this piece?
- d. Read pages 16-top of page 19 in *Life of an Artist* book. (5 minutes)
- e. Introduce activity. (15 minutes)
 - Students will use the photo of celebrations that they brought from home to design their Post covers. Alternative: Students can draw something they are thankful for.
 - The key is to provide detail and draw what they see. In addition, students will name and date their covers.
- f. Ask for volunteers to present their work to their peers. (5 minutes)
- V. Wrap up exercise
 - a. Who Can Tell Me the name of the artist?
 - b. Who can tell me that name of the masterpieces?
 - c. Who can tell me one nifty fact about the artist or the masterpiece?
